The Water System has experienced problems with our water supply system. Because of these problems, the water produced by our water supply system is of questionable microbiological quality. Therefore, as a precaution, the Water System is issuing a BOIL ADVISORY effective immediately. This BOIL ADVISORY is to remain in effect until rescinded by the Water System. The areas affected by this advisory are residents on Holly Grove Rd., Tammy St., KCS Dr., Virginia ST., Thaxton Landing, Allen Dale Dr., Bourbon ST., Fairlane Rd., Desoto Dr., Tilley Dr., Pointe South Rd., Wooduck Rd., Liles Rd., Kuhls Rd., Holton Harris Rd., Pearls Ln., Carlon St., Blaine St., Janna St., Courtney Paige Lp., Sunshine Dr., McNeely Rd., Brown Rd., Gazebo Ln., Calvin St., JE Haymon Rd., Teal Rd., Walter Dixon Rd.

It is recommended that all consumers disinfect their water before consuming it (including fountain drinks), making ice, brushing teeth, or using it for food preparation or rinsing of foods by the following means: Boil water for one (1) full minute in a clean container. The one minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. (The flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle, pouring it from one clean container to another, or by adding a small pinch of salt to each quart of water that is boiled.)

Again, please be sure to disinfect your own water prior to consumption until you have been advised otherwise.

The Water System will rescind this Boil Advisory upon notification from the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals - Office of Public Health that additional water samples collected from our water supply system have shown our water to be safe.
